### Federal Stafford Loan Information

Loans will be processed for the maximum amount you are eligible to receive during the loan period. If you wish to decline or reduce your loan amount, notify the Office of Financial Aid. Each Stafford Loan can be processed for a maximum of two consecutive semesters (e.g. summer/fall).

The aggregate maximum (including debt from undergraduate and other programs) under the Federal Stafford Loan Program is \$65,500 for subsidized loans and \$138,500 for subsidized and unsubsidized combined. You may not borrow additional Federal Stafford Loans if you reach the maximum.

### Student Disclosure Statement and Signature

I certify that the information contained in this application is true and complete. I will notify the Office of Financial Aid in writing of any change in my family's financial status. If I have questions about summer financial aid and my eligibility, I will consult with the Office of Financial Aid. I understand:

1. I must be enrolled at least half-time to receive a loan for summer school.
2. I must notify the Office of Financial Aid if I decide not to attend summer school.
3. If studying away or abroad, the Office of Financial Aid cannot guarantee my loan proceeds will be available to me before I leave the United States if my forms are submitted late.
4. If my Federal Stafford Loan is in excess of Suffolk University charges for tuition and fees, I voluntarily authorize this excess to be applied to other Suffolk charges. I understand that I may rescind this authorization at any time.
5. If I withdraw from a summer class after the class begins and receive federal loans, the Office of Financial Aid must recalculate my federal loan eligibility. If I withdraw from my summer program once the semester has begun, I will be assessed tuition liability as stated by the Office of the Bursar and my Federal Stafford Loan eligibility will be recalculated in accordance with federal regulations. This could result in an outstanding tuition balance owed to Suffolk University.
